#### **DISCUSSION POINTS**

The Steering Committee recommended moving forward with the following zoning regulations in these areas:

Courthouse Square and Downtown Commercial – Form-based code
The preservation of historic buildings and context sensitive development for new buildings are important in this area. A form-based code can identify areas of different character, identify permitted building forms and mass, and potentially designate specific buildings for preservation.

Residential Core – Conservation subdivision with natural resource protection

The number of rooftops in this Residential Core area is important to the economic vitality of the commercial areas in Independence. Preserving natural features and minimizing any negative impact on the surrounding property is critical to properly integrate new residential development into Independence.

McCullum/New KY 17 – Traditional commercial zoning with design standards Make sure new development looks nice in this area. Buffering from the adjacent residential uses is important. High density multi-family residential should be a permitted use within this zone, but not a requirement.
